
Spot the Difference!




Sunny dropped his ice cream on the sand! Help him find the way through the maze to get it back. Start at the nest and end at the ice cream cone.















A cool croc, mate!



KOOKABURRA FUN FACTS




Their call sounds like big, happy laughter, but it's actually how they talk to each other.
